#### **Code of Conduct**

## No Public Display of Affection:

- \*No kissing, caressing, sitting on another person's lap
- \*No inappropriate dancing

# No Leaving the Premises:

- \*For your safety, once you arrive at the Exchange, we ask that you remain in the building until prom is over. (No going out to the parking lots without an adult, no hanging out on the sidewalks.)
- \*If someone needs something from their car, they must check out with a chaperone and be escorted to and from their vehicle by chaperones.
- \*If you decide to leave the prom before 11pm, chaperones will escort you to your vehicle. You will not be allowed to return to prom after you have left the premises.

## Drugs, Alcohol, and Cigarettes:
