Code of Conduct

The following will allow attendees and guests of the RCHS Prom to have a full understanding of what will be permitted and what is not allowed at this event.

Please review this information carefully regarding the proper behavior and accepted attire for prom. Failure to adhere to this Code of Conduct and Dress Code may result in expulsion from the Prom.

No Public Display of Affection:

- *No kissing, caressing, sitting on another person's lap
- *No inappropriate dancing

No Leaving the Premises:

- *For your safety, once you arrive at the Exchange, we ask that you remain in the building until prom is over. (No going out to the parking lots without an adult, no hanging out on the sidewalks.)
- *If someone needs something from their car, they must check out with a chaperone and be escorted to and from their vehicle by chaperones.
- *If you decide to leave the prom before 11pm, chaperones will escort you to your vehicle. You will not be allowed to return to prom after you have left the premises.

Drugs, Alcohol, and Cigarettes:

- *The RCHS Prom has a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY when it comes to these matters.
- *Also, cigarette smoking is not allowed and no one may bring any drinks into prom, including water, soda, power drinks, etc.

Dress Code

Please remember, the RCHS Prom is a Black Tie Event.

Ladies:

- *Long gowns are encouraged, but not required.
- *Modest and becoming gowns are expected.
- *Short dresses and slits should not be higher than 2 – 3 “ above the knee.
- *Spaghetti straps and strapless gowns are permitted.
- *No plunging necklines or low cut backs below middle of the back.
- *No see through gowns.

Gentlemen:

- *Tuxedo or Dress Suit.
- *Neckties or Bow Ties are recommended.
- *Collared, button-up dress shirts—No T-shirts.

Everyone:

- *Most important—Christ-like behavior is expected.
- *Please use your best discretion when selecting your attire for the RCHS Prom.
- *Any activity by attendees or guests that are deemed inappropriate or dangerous to others will be dealt with at the discretion of the chaperones.
